

NRA PERSONAL PROTECTION COURSE

November 14th, 2009

There will be a NRA "Personal Protection in the Home" Course taught at the Hillrose Town Hall, Saturday, November 14th 8:00am to 6:30 pm. **This will be an 11 hour course that will satisfy the training requirements required by the state of Colorado to obtain a Concealed Weapons permit.** The charge for this course is \$100.00.

This course will be taught by certified NRA instructors and will include the following topics:

- * The 4 basic levels of awareness and how to avoid a deadly confrontation
- * The defensive mindset
- * How to make you and your home safer
- * Basic firearm safety
- * Safe firearm storage
- * The laws in the state of Colorado concerning:
 - * Use of deadly force
 - * Purchasing, transporting and using a firearm
 - * Statutes concerning the use and carry of concealed weapons
- * Confronting an intruder or attacker
- * Psychological and physiological reactions to a threatening situation
- * Defense against a knife attack
- * Selecting a firearm for personal protection
- * The aftermath of a defensive shooting
- * Defensive shooting practice versus bull's-eye shooting



This course will also include 4 hours of range time in which the student will need 100 rounds of ammunition, hearing and eye protection, and a handgun suitable for self-defense. (It is generally recommended a minimum caliber of 9mm in semi-auto or 38 special in revolver). **If you do not yet have a handgun, we will have several you can use, in this case just bring 100 rounds of 9mm ammunition.**

You must be 21 years of age and legally able to possess a firearm in the State of Colorado to take this course.
